

Mandatory Subcontractor Declaration

At the time of bid submission bidders must provide a list of all subcontractors they intend to use on this project. Each subcontractor's union affiliation, as required by the MCSTC, must be specified. Failure to submit this information may result in disqualification due to a non-compliant bid.

The bidder agrees that no changes to the Subcontractor Declaration will be allowed without submitting a written request to TDSB including the reason for the change and ensuring that the new subcontractor has the proper union affiliation(s). (If Applicable)

TDSB reserves the rights, at its sole discretion, to request any or all sub-contractor(s) to be replaced, prior to or after tender award.

For Fair Wage Projects Union Affiliations will not be required and should be left blank.

The contractor is expected to disclose all major trades by filling out the table below **completely** and **must** indicate if that trade's work will be done by themselves (Own Forces), by a Subcontractor (Subcontractor name), or Not Applicable to this project (N/A). If required, blank rows have been included in order to add additional Trades that are not listed.
